

# Foundation Phonic Lessons

At Long Crendon School we use a scheme called 'Jolly phonics' which we use all through Key Stage 1. It uses a multi-sensory approach to help access different learning styles. The three main styles of learning are: Visual, Auditory and Kinaesthetic. These different styles are accounted for when delivering the Jolly Phonics programme and make for a fun and interactive learning experience.
