PTA 100 CLUB

Next week all parents in school will be receiving a letter/sign up form for the PTA's '100 Club' which is organised for the PTA to raise money for the school. The '100 Club' is a monthly draw where we sell 100 numbered balls (1 to 100) for £11 each which covers 12 draws (£1 a month with a month free of charge). There is a monthly draw in school assembly where children pick 3 balls out of the container and the person who purchased these 3 numbered balls wins a cash prize. We would love to sell all 100 balls this year to raise maximum funds for the PTA and also to maximise the prize fund for everyone who buys a numbered ball. You are able to buy more than one numbered ball if you would like to (the sky is the limit!)

Half the money raised from the sale of balls goes to the PTA and half is used for the prize fund for the monthly winners.

The form that will be put into book bags will give details of how to buy a ball. If you have a lucky number then do get in there quickly to buy it as numbers are sold on a first come first served basis. If you are a current ball holder we will be in contact and hope that you will renew your lucky numbers!

We will also be selling balls on some days from next week before school pick up.

An example of how some of the money raised by the 100 Club has been used in the last school year includes all 30 Ukulele instruments for the music room, allowing a whole class the opportunity to learn the instrument, which is fantastic!

This is a great way to raise money for the school and potentially yourself if your ball is drawn. Hopefully you will consider buying a numbered ball(s) for the new 12 month series which starts in October. Remember you have to be in it to win it !!
