...that's **£208,110** a year across the school!

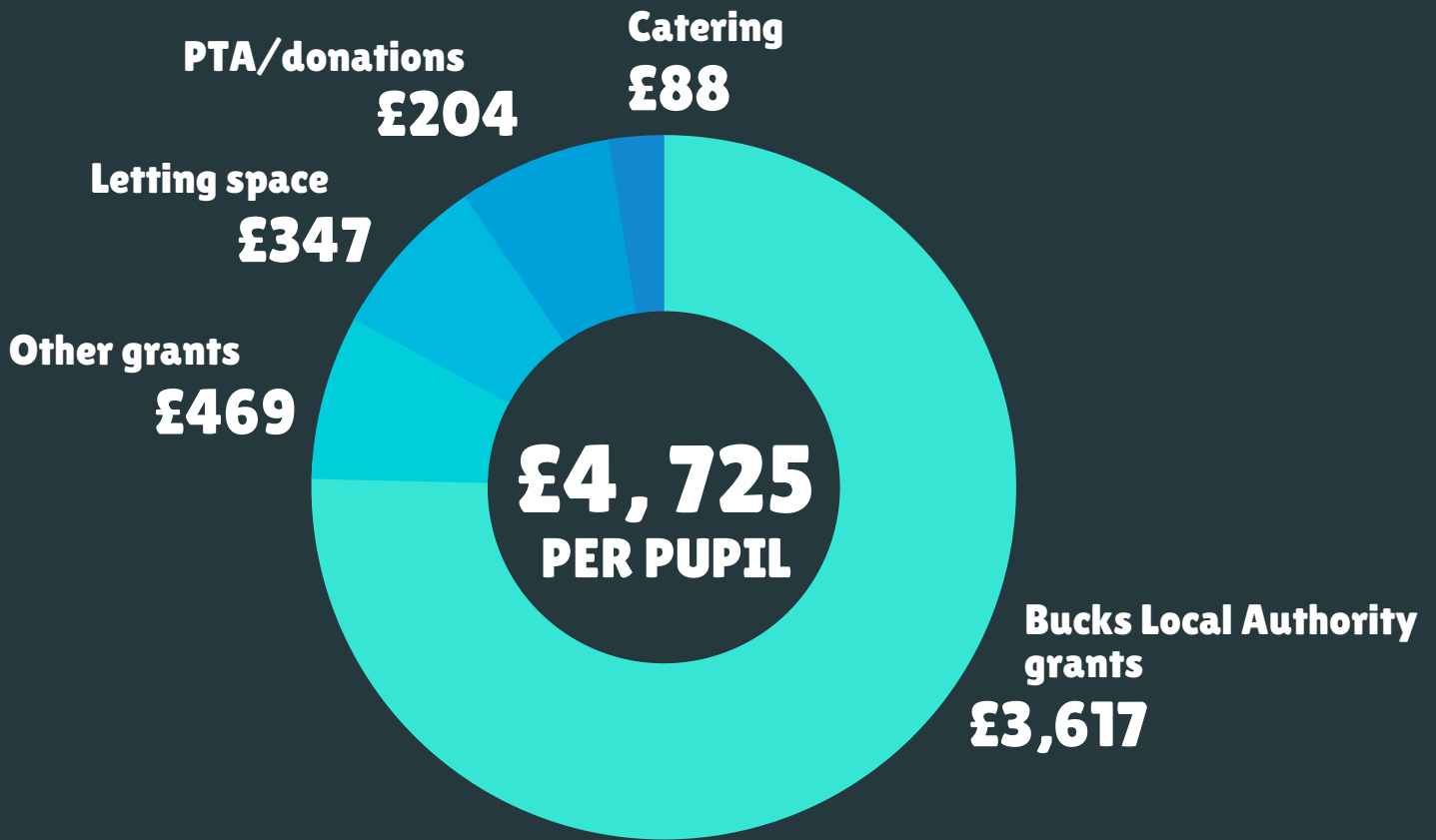
WITHOUT FINANCIAL HELP FROM PARENTS

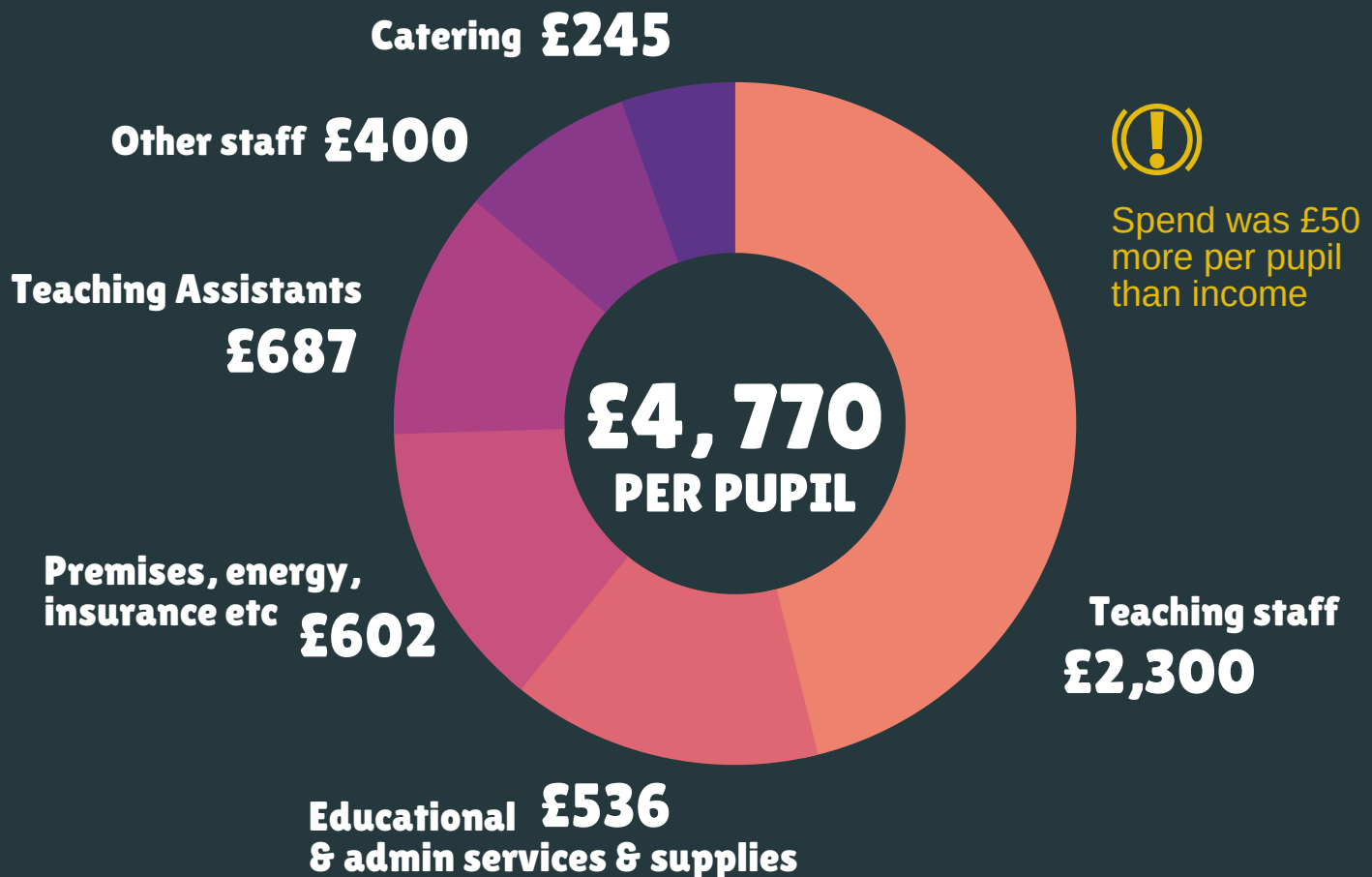

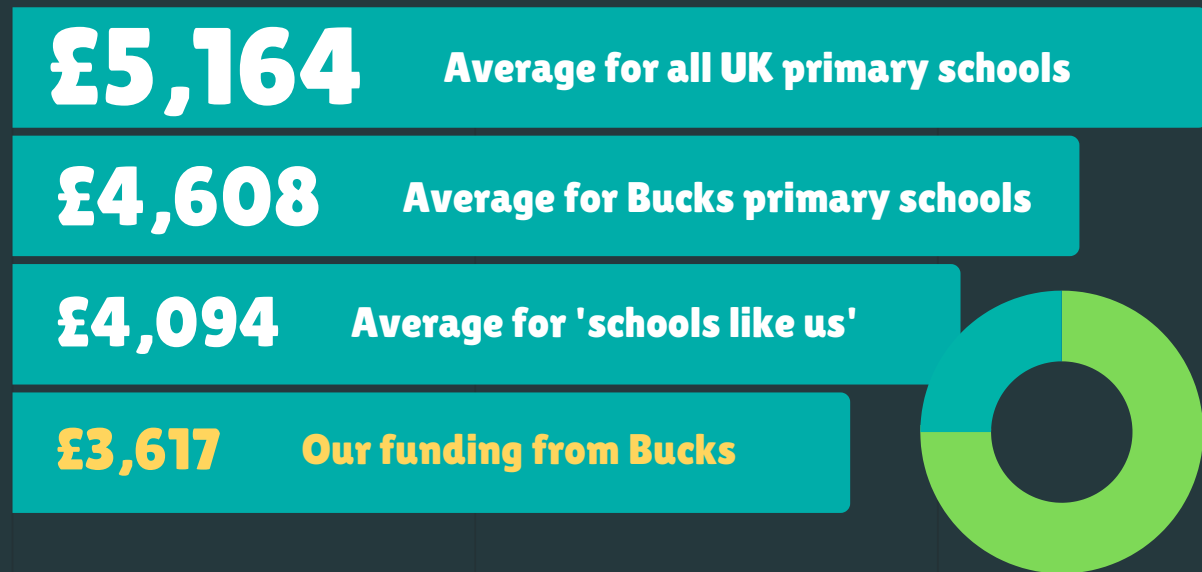
THE SCHOOL'S INCOME IN 2018-19

HOW DOES OUR FUNDING FROM BUCKS LA GRANTS COMPARE WITH OTHER SCHOOLS?



Long Crendon's funding from Bucks LA puts us in the **lowest 9%** of schools like us, the **lowest 27%** of primary schools in Buckinghamshire and the **lowest 17%** of primary schools nationwide.

WHY ARE WE SO UNDERFUNDED?

Compared to the rest of the UK



Bucks Local Authority is **one of the most underfunded** in the country...

Which means the amount it has to divide among its schools is lower to begin with.

Compared to the rest of Bucks



Bucks gives more money for pupils in care, with SEN, on Free School Meals, who change schools, who have English as a second language, with low prior attainment, or who live in a deprived area.

We meet very few of these and other criteria for additional funds.
