

ENGLISH

Our English will link with science and geography this half term. We will use Spotty the jaguar's information from WWF plus other picture books including The Great Kapok Tree to inspire our writing.

MATHS

We will be focusing on multiplication and division this half term and then will move on to fractions and time.

GEOGRAPHY

Geography will be taught through science and English. We will use our globes and atlases to locate areas around the world and animals that live in those habitats. Our focus will be on the Amazon Rainforest.

ART

Working with materials to make natural sculptures. We will explore the work of Andy Goldsworthy and other environmental artists. We will focus on different techniques such as model making, observational drawing, collecting materials, ephemeral land art and group sculpture building.

READING

We will be learning how to answer different types of questions (retrieval, inference, vocabulary, sequencing and predicting). We will use texts linked to our topic.
