Take pictures of yourself being a 'superkid' at home. Maybe you tidied your room or helped wash the dishes?



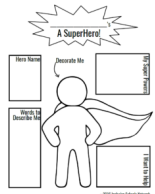
Stick them in your learning log and write a caption for each.
