What we raised last year!

The PTA raised around £37k last school year, which is astounding! As we showed you in our funding primer earlier this year, our grant per pupil from Bucks Local Authority was £3,501, compared to £4,868 average for other schools in Bucks, and £5,373 average for all UK primary schools*. With such underfunding, it makes the PTA's relentless work to keep donations coming into the school all the more vital. We sincerely thank each and every one of you for your continued support. Without it, the school wouldn't be able to buy anything new for our children; we couldn't afford licenses for software; to upgrade the IT suite as we're currently doing so each child can work at a computer without having to share; to give them experience days and new sports equipment; new dining room furniture and much more.
