We're really looking forward to the return of Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y5 next week. With only three weeks to go to the end of term, it will be the first time since March that all the Long Crendon children will be returning. We're aware that some local schools are making different decisions, based on their premises and staff available. Buckinghamshire Council have told Bucks headteachers that they will support us in doing what we think is best for our individual schools.

The staff have been busy this week preparing for the wider reopening by setting up classrooms – most classes will be returning to their own rooms. As there is some structural work being done on the Y4 and Y3 rooms, Y4 will move temporarily into the Y6 classroom, whilst Y6 will remain in the hall. Y3 will be taking their lessons in the music room.

Thanks to the PTA, who funded the purchase of a number of water butts, we have been able to set up mobile handwashing stations outside, to speed up the many handwashing sessions needed at the moment.
